# EAGLE DANCE 2026

## Centre for Shamanic Arts of the Sweet Medicine Sundance Path



**June 5-7 2026**

**Surrey, UK**

The Eagle Dance is a traditional and powerful ceremony. We dance to the Tree of Life from dawn 'til dusk, pulled by the powerful rhythm of traditional chants, to connect with our higher vision and purpose for the year ahead.

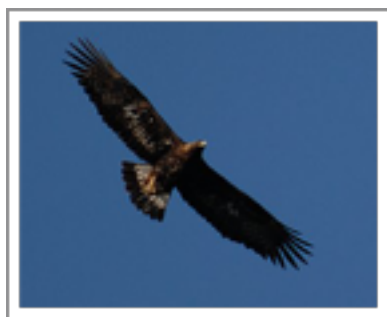
The ceremony begins on Friday 5th June with a whole camp gathering at 2pm. You should arrive, set up your camp and register before then. There will be a Purification Lodge on Friday evening. We will dance all day on Saturday 6th and then, in the evening, we will enjoy a ceremonial feast.

On Sunday we will all help with the take-down, leaving the land even more beautiful than we found it. We aim to be finished by midday on Sunday 7th June.

There is an opportunity to be on the land in service as a Dog Soldier. They are the keepers and guardians of the space, the ceremony and the people. They provide practical support and protection, especially during the dance. No experience is necessary. If you have completed 4 dances or you have never been to an Eagle Dance before, we invite you to consider this option of being in service.

### **PLEASE NOTE**

**No alcohol or non-prescription drugs are allowed on the land  
Please do not bring children or pets - this event is not suitable for either.  
Everybody needs to be on the land and registered by 4pm Friday 5th June.**



**Preparations Before the Eagle Dance** - before the dance, you need to prepare the following:

- **Shield** depicting your vision for the year ahead. A shield is normally made of something from the plant and animal worlds, e.g. a willow hoop and a leather base. Acrylic paints work well and are weatherproof
- **Forked stick** to be set in the ground to hold your shield. The 'V' of the fork should ideally be at the level of your heart when standing when the stick is planted 6 to 8 inches into the ground
- **Hokkshideh bundle** (a small protection bundle worn on a thong or chain around the neck.) Cost £10. ***If you need a Hokkshideh bundle please contact Pete Edwards ASAP - contact details below***
- **SunDance Regalia** comprising:
  - Long, fringed skirt, mid-calf/ ankle length
  - Sash or wide belt.
  - Ribbons to hang on your shirt, with safety pins, from both shoulders or wide apart on the chest. You must have the 4 directional colours of red, black, white, yellow. If you wish, you can also add the As Above and So Below colours of blue & green, and/or all the rainbow colours not already included i.e. orange, green, blue, indigo and violet
- **Medicine blanket** to carry over left shoulder. Can be a shawl, wide scarf etc.
- **Eagle whistle and 2 eagle plumes** these are usually made of turkey (aka ground eagle) bone and fluff. ***If you need these please contact Pete Edwards ASAP - contact details below***
- **Corn paho** blue corn meal, available for purchase at the dance
- **Tobacco** Each person brings tobacco and a medicine gift for the Dance Chief. You may also wish to gift the Drum Team and Dog Soldier Team to honour the energy exchange
- **Purification Lodge gear** including medicine gifts and tobacco for DC & Fire Crew. You will be informed nearer the time whether there will be a Purification Lodge

## **Costs**

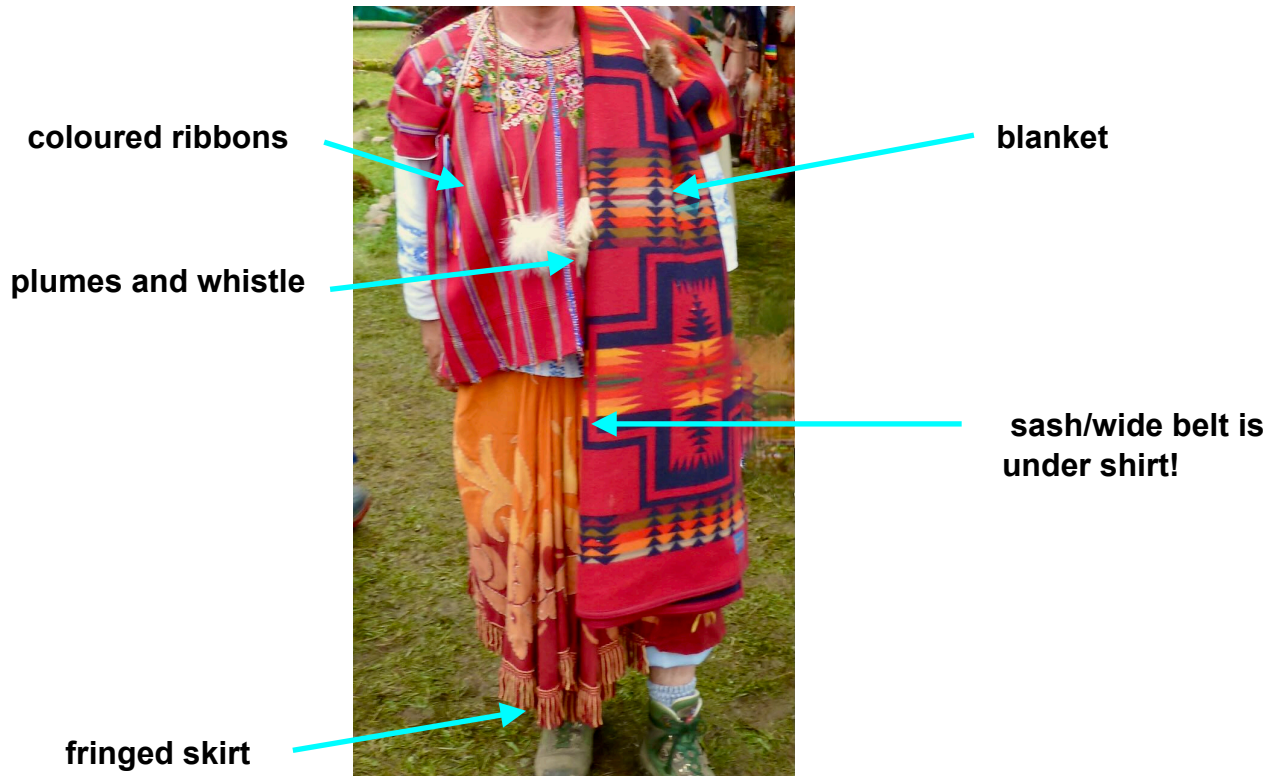
